KIA ORA E TE WHĀNAU

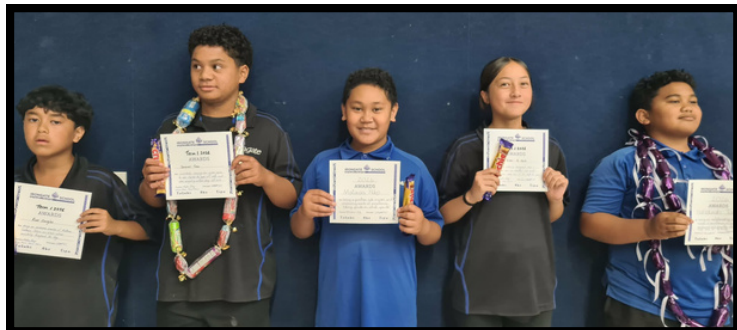

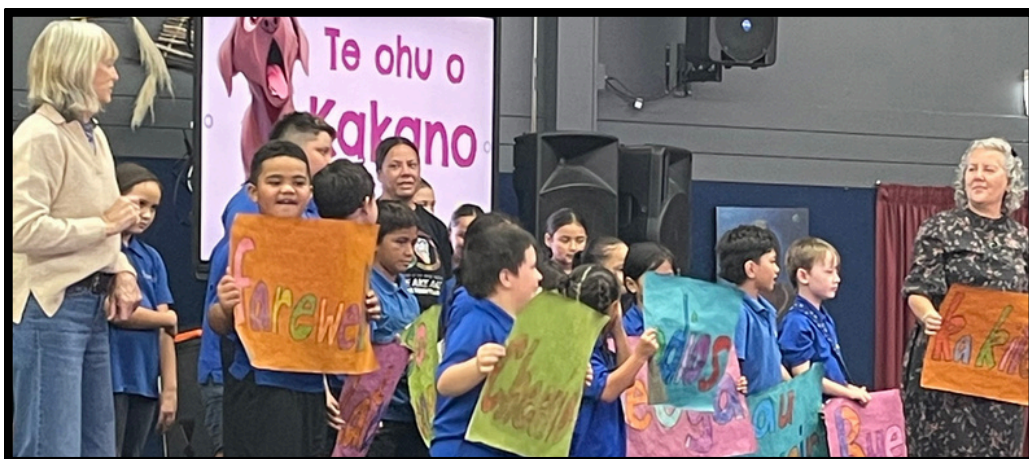


FAREWELL FOR KAREN
