Important Health Notice for Our Whānau ❤️

We have seen an increase in Influenza A across our kura, affecting students, staff and whānau. Please help us protect our tamariki, kaumātua and wider whānau by slowing the spread.

🤒 *Flu symptoms may include: fever/chills, cough or sore throat, body aches, tiredness, runny nose, headache, or upset stomach.*

🏠 *Please keep tamariki home if they are unwell. They can return once they have been symptom-free for at least 24 hours without medication.*

💧 *Please remind children to wash their hands regularly and cover coughs and sneezes with their elbow.*

If symptoms worsen or don't improve after a few days, please contact your doctor or medical centre.
